IMPORTANT NOTICE

Dear Valued Customer,

The San Bernardino County Special Districts Department, Water and Sanitation Division (Division) would like to thank all of our customers for their conservation efforts during the recent drought. At this time, the restrictions on specific watering days are no longer in effect due to the significant amount of precipitation that the local areas have received. As of the date of this letter, customers may resume their normal outdoor irrigation schedules.

On April 7, 2017, Governor Brown issued Executive Order B-40-17 terminating the Drought State of Emergency issued in 2014. The order states; however, that Californians will continue with Executive Order B-37-16 Making Conservation a California Way of Life, including permanent restrictions that shall prohibit wasteful practices such as:

- Hosing off sidewalks, driveways and other hardscapes;
- Washing automobiles with hoses not equipped with a shut-off nozzle;
- Using non-recirculated water in a fountain or other decorative water feature;
- Watering lawns in a manner that causes runoff, or within 48 hours after measurable precipitation; and
- Irrigating ornamental turf on public street medians.
