

## Rancho Cucamonga Fire Protection District San Bernardino County Fire Department Joint Closure Order North Etiwanda Preserve Closure Order Number 2022-003



Pursuant to Rancho Cucamonga Fire Protection District Ordinance FD-057 and San Bernardino County Fire Code Section 11, due to forecasted heavy rain accompanied by flooding; to prevent patrons being trapped or injured by flood waters; and to provide for general public safety, the following act is prohibited within the North Etiwanda Preserve:

Going into or being upon the land within the North Etiwanda Preserve. The closure area is shown in Exhibit A.

This Order is effective from 8:00 AM Monday November 7, 2022, until sunrise Thursday November 10, 2022.

Pursuant to Rancho Cucamonga Fire Protection District Ordinance FD-057 and San Bernardino County Fire Code Section 11, the following persons are exempt from this Order:

- 1. Peace or police officers; officials and employees of the Rancho Cucamonga Fire District, San Bernardino County Fire Department, CalFire, US Forest Service, and automatic and mutual aid fire departments; and all other public officials while in the course of duty and having legitimate business within the affected area,
- 2. Authorized persons engaged in the maintenance, repair, or installation of equipment owned and/or operated by public or private utilities or communications systems,
- 3. Persons with specific special access rights as granted by San Bernardino County, Special Districts Department.

This prohibition is in addition to the Rules and Regulations of the North Etiwanda Preserve.
