

Rancho Cucamonga Fire Protection District San Bernardino County Fire Department Joint Closure Order North Etiwanda Preserve Closure Order Number 2023-004



Pursuant to Rancho Cucamonga Fire Protection District Ordinance FD-058 and San Bernardino County Fire Code Section 11, due to forecasted rain and snow melt with the potential for flooding and current ground saturation levels that could result land or rock slides and/or debris flows; to prevent patrons being trapped or injured by flood waters and/or debris; and to provide for general public safety, the following act is prohibited within the North Etiwanda Preserve:

Going into or being upon the land within the North Etiwanda Preserve. The closure area is shown in Exhibit A.

This Order is effective from sundown Thursday March 9, 2023, until sunrise Thursday March 16, 2023.

Pursuant to Rancho Cucamonga Fire Protection District Ordinance FD-058 and San Bernardino County Fire Code Section 11, the following persons are exempt from this Order:

- 1. Peace or police officers; officials and employees of the Rancho Cucamonga Fire District, San Bernardino County Fire Department, CalFire, US Forest Service, and automatic and mutual aid fire departments; and all other public officials while in the course of duty and having legitimate business within the affected area,
- 2. Authorized persons engaged in the maintenance, repair, or installation of equipment owned and/or operated by public or private utilities or communications systems,
- 3. Persons with specific special access rights as granted by San Bernardino County, Special Districts Department.

This prohibition is in addition to the Rules and Regulations of the North Etiwanda Preserve. A violation of this Order is punishable by a fine of \$1,000.
